WELCOME

DanceHub CIC, with the Let's Dance Trust's blessing, are proud to produce this annual event working with The Hawth Theatre to bring Let's Dance Crawley 2027 and beyond.



Let's Dance Crawley 2027 will be a key part of DaM Fest'27, taking place throughout March with a

dynamic line-up of events, activities, and campaigns celebrating Dance and Movement across Crawley. Stay tuned, more details coming soon!

WHAT IS LET'S DANCE?

Let's Dance Crawley aims to bring together schools and colleges from across Crawley in an exciting and engaging celebration of Dance and Movement.

It is an inclusive and accessible space for schools and colleges to come together and perform on The Hawth stage within a supportive and encouraging environment.

PERFORMANCE REGULATIONS

Each group can have up to a total of 24 dancers and a suitable number of DBS staff to supervise.

All performances must be suitable for a family audience (this includes radio edits of music, costumes, props and dance content).

Each group will be required for technical rehearsals during the day on Monday 8th or Tuesday 9th March 2027.

Only participating performers and DBS staff are permitted backstage and must stay backstage for the duration of the show.

Recording or photographing any part of the performance is strictly prohibited for both participating groups and members of the public.

Performances must be no more than 4 mins long.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Groups must register by completing the application form which is available on our website and will be emailed to you once the applications are live.

Please note, there is an £125 registration fee to help cover admin costs and you will need to provide two email contacts from your school, which will need to be checked regularly from Sept'26.

You will receive an email to confirm your application has been received.

Once all applications have been reviewed, you will receive an email confirming your performance in Let's Dance Crawley 2027 – this should be no later than end of October 2026.

AFTER REGISTRATION, WHAT'S NEXT?

Following your email confirmation, there will be a series of paperwork that is required to complete your participation in Let's Dance Crawley 2027. The documentation needed will be:

Participants and staff information

In this document we need to know how many performers you will have, names of DBS staff as well as any medical conditions we need to be aware of.

Music and Lighting requirements

Must be submitted as an MP3 file along with brief lighting requirements.

Media Consent form

Photographs and recordings taken during Let's Dance Crawley 2027 will be used on DanceHub social media pages, website and in our marketing materials and will be available to purchase. DanceHub will not use images unless parent/guardian permission has been obtained.

Deadlines for the above documentation will be shared with you. Failure to provide the above by given deadlines could impact your groups participation in Let's Dance Crawley 2027.

WHAT WILL BE EXPECTED OF ME AND MY DANCERS?

- All participants must remain in the venue for the duration of the event after arrival and groups will be dismissed from the venue by DanceHub Staff.
- Parents will not be allowed to go to dressing rooms or backstage at any time including for collection, regardless of where in the auditorium they are seated. The DanceHub team are also not responsible for connecting dancers and parents' post-event but will require your groups leader to provide a group sign out with a DanceHub staff member.
- We will not tolerate any negative behaviour, from either dancers, teachers, chaperones or audience members towards staff or other dance communities. Any abusive or negative behaviour will be noted and could lead to your dance school being removed from Let's Dance applications going forward. We operate a one warning policy before action is taken.
